The new ArrowCat 30, a next generation powercat designed in New Zealand, charts a new course in family fun, entertainment and comfortable living onboard. What's more, the

ArrowCat is built to perform at all speeds yet withstand rough conditions – giving you the best of both worlds.

Strand-based Magson Marine will be the country's sole agent and distributor of the ArrowCat 30 and is expecting their first shipment as soon as the end of July. Owner Ernie Magson is extremely excited about bringing the ArrowCat to our shores.

"She's only 30 feet long, but features similar amenities such as a roomy interior and exceptional

finishing as a 40-footer," said Ernie. According to him, the upmarket family boater looking for extravagant comfort and unmatched finishes will find the ArrowCat 30 very appealing.

Those who've seen our review of Magson's Maximum Titan 30 (January 2009), may see a similarity in design. However, even though the ArrowCat has the same capabilities, it boasts more luxuries, amenities and plenty of room.

New Zealand's internationally recognised yacht designer Roger Hill has designed, engineered and ocean-tested the ArrowCat 30. The hull comprises of 22 layers of hand-laid fibreglass using advanced composite technology from a world-renowned company.

The ArrowCat's roomy interior offers comfortable sleeping arrangements for six adults. Sportsmen and divers will appreciate the rugged characteristics of a well-laid out cockpit – complete with macerator fishbox and enormous storage compartments.

Combine the integrated swimplatform with aft deck and other features such as hot/cold transom shower, raw water



washdown and rodholders, and you'll agree that this boat has it all. "All boaters value a stylish, tough vessel that meets their highest expectations," said Ernie.

Performance

The ArrowCat's unique hull design offers the best of both displacement and planing hull technologies. Stability and seaworthiness are merged with speed and best-in-class fuel efficiency, while its wide stance and sharp bow entry with ample tunnel height delivers unparalleled performance and efficiency.

According to the manufacturer, the ArrowCat burns only 37-litres per hour at a speed of 20 knots. With its incredible fuel-economy and 500 km range, ArrowCat delivers next generation fuel efficiency.

Ernie is looking at fitting the ArrowCat 30 with twin 2-Stroke, 150 HP Yamaha motors, which are renowned for being very economical, adding to the already fuel-efficiency of the ArrowCat 30.

Durability

Each ArrowCat is built using over a thousand man hours. The meticulous hand-built foam core composite construction can never rot and provides owners with the strongest, most durable technology money can buy.

The boat will remain stiff and quiet because it is all bonded into one unit. "She'll handle anything the rough Cape seas can throw at her," said Ernie. She's been tested in the notoriously rough waters of Australia and New Zealand, and passed with flying colours," he said.

Life onboard

The ArrowCat 30's interior has a spacious modern design with nearly 360 degree's of visibility from the entire saloon. A mid-ship helm station has room for the most modern full-size displays and provides a commanding view of the entire vessel.

The full galley is appointed with a moulded composite countertop system, cherry finished cabinets and of course,



lots of latch drawers. The galley comes standard with hot and cold water at the large moulded sink, a microwave compartment and two-burner stove. The oversize seats offers seating for the entire family and the seamless flow of space keeps the entire crew together.

Down below, a well lit, all-composite, enclosed head compartment featuring a full size toilet, separate shower and vanity sink with hot/cold faucets offers all the comforts and privacy of any home.

The forward master stateroom features a queen size mattress and plenty of enclosed storage. Two adult-size mid-berths allow two more to comfortably sleep in the separate aft quarters.

The roomy aft cockpit and swim platform invite all kinds of activities from trophy fishing to snorkelling and scuba diving. Enormous lazarette

compartments or insulated fish boxes below keeps the aft deck free and clear, while the hot and cold transom shower and a raw water washdown make rinsing a breeze.

"The ArrowCat 30 has plenty of benefits. She has quality, durability, fuel-efficiency and speed. Because it's lighter and more compact, it also proves easier to handle," said Ernie.

What's more, her handling and performance is sound. She's capable of accommodating six people in it's plush and roomy interior. But whether, you want to go fishing, cruise with family deep offshore or just have some fun, the ArrowCat is more than adequate and simply oozing with style.
